BACKGROUND TO HOLY TRINITY WANDSWORTH

Holy Trinity Wandsworth is in South-West London (Zone 2) with a mission to know Christ and make Him known to the people of SW London.

Our main Sunday service is at 10.30am with approx. 65 adults and 15 children each week. We have a growing fringe and we are seeing people increase in their regularity of attendance. In due course, we would like to plant more services – possibly a family service in the afternoon and/or an evening service.

David Simpson started as the Vicar in July 2023 after a curacy at HTB and theological college at Oak Hill. We want to be a church that takes the Word of God seriously and is led by the Spirit in mission and holiness.

Wandsworth is a vibrant Borough with the highest proportion of young adults in the country. There is also a lot of socio-economic and ethnic diversity, which brings a vibrancy to life in the community.

PURPOSE OF ROLE

This is a great opportunity for a fun-loving, energetic Youth & Kids Worker who is excited by the idea of reaching youth, children and their families with the good news of Jesus and the adventure of following him.

We believe that children and young people's engagement with church should be fun, safe and a great way to make friends, whilst encountering God. Reaching young people is crucial for the future of the church, so we want someone who can help us reach families in the area.

The Youth & Kids Worker would work closely with the Vicar to develop a three-year curriculum of Kids church content (for Sundays), weekly devotionals and events that would work alongside the curriculum. The hope is to offer the curriculum to other churches through various networks that the church is linked with.

- Teach, lead and encourage kids in whole of life discipleship
- Oversee and develop kids program at church services and other events, including special church services & creative events to engage youth, kids and families in the Parish
- Run a Friday night Youth Group
- Run an after-school homework club
- Coordinate the August holiday club for primary school children in the Parish
- Prioritise excellent safeguarding processes and practices, ensuring they comply with diocesan and government requirements
- Develop and apply the SEN strategy
- Identify, recruit, train and develop kids team leaders, members, and interns
- Coordinate and deliver pastoral care and oversight of kids team leaders, members, and interns
- Assist the Vicar in the engagement and support of kids parents and guardians as they navigate parenting with or without faith
- Oversee the set-up, purchasing and development of equipment and materials for kids & families engagement and manage the budget
- Organise Kids Church rotas and termly training sessions
- Build links and deliver Christian assemblies/ classes in the local schools
- Work with the Vicar to develop 3 year Kids curriculum
